Mr and Mrs Robert Campbell, of Waituna, Waimate, have received word that their second son, Private James Campbell, died of wounds in France on December 7. Private Campbell, who was 25 years of age, enlisted in the 14th Reinforcements of the New Zealand Rifle Brigade. He was educated at the Waituna School, and, after working about home for some time, entered the employ of Mr H. M. Hertalet, AdendaJe, by whom he was much valued for his unassuming nature and faithful service. He was deservedly popular. Mr and Mrs Campbell have given two sons for the cause of King and Empire, their eldest son, John Robert, having died of wounds inflicted at Gallipoli in 1915.
