«b»Adrian Goodenough Hayter«/b» «u»MBE«/u» (22 December 1914 \endash 14 June 1990) was a «u»New Zealand «/u» soldier, sailor, Antarctic leader and author. «b»Biography

«/b»Hayter was born in «u»Timaru «/u» in 1914 and was educated at «u»Nelson College «/u» from 1926 to 1931 He then went to «u»Sandhurst «/u» and was attached to 1st Battalion «u»East Surrey Regiment «/u» in India, before joining his regiment, the «u»2nd King Edward VII's Own Gurkha Rifles «/u», in 1934. He was awarded the «u»Military Cross «/u» for actions in «u»Burma«/u» in 1944

Hayter left the army in 1947, but returned to his regiment during the early years of the «u»Malayan Emergency «/u», and later became the chief instructor at the Jungle Warfare School. In December 1949, he was appointed a «u»Member of the Order of the British Empire «/u», for services in Malaya.He later wrote of his experiences in the army in the book «i»The Second Step«/i», which was published in 1962.

In 1950, Hayter resigned his commission, and travelled to England where bought a 32-foot «u»yawl «/u» called «i»Sheila II«/i». After learning the basics of celestial navigation by correspondence, he sailed to New Zealand via Gibraltar, the Suez Canal, India, Malaya and Australia, finally arriving in «u»Westport «/u» in 1956. In doing so, he became the first person to sail solo from the United Kingdom to New Zealand. He recounted the story of his journey in the book «i»Sheila in the Wind«/i», published in 1959.

Hayter returned to Britain in 1961 and purchased the Norwegian-built 25-foot sloop «i»Valkyr«/i», which he sailed solo to New Zealand via the Canary Islands and the Panama Canal. He wrote of his experiences in «i»Business in Great Waters«/i», published in 1965.«u»[3]«/u»

After his return to New Zealand, Hayter became the sailing instructor at the newly opened Cobham «u»Outward Bound «/u» School at «u»Anakiwa «/u»

In 1964, Hayter was appointed to head the New Zealand Antarctic expedition for a year at «u»Scott Base «/u», where he wintered over. Once again, he wrote a book, «i»The Year of the Quiet Sun«/i» (published 1968) about his experience. Subsequently, he was awarded the «u»Polar Medal «/u» in 1969.

Hayter twice stood unsuccessfully for the «u»New Zealand parliament «/u» in the «u»Tasman electorate «/u», the first time in «u»1975 «/u» as an independent candidate, and then in «u»1984 «/u» under the banner of the «u»New Zealand Party «/u»

Hayter died in «u»Nelson, New Zealand «/u» from cancer in 1990.

At the conclusion of a formation flypast to commemorate the end of the London-Christchurch Air Race on Thursday 15 October 1953 was involved in a mid air collision with NZ1810 over Wigram. The Devon crashed into a paddock about 200 yards from NZ1810 and was destroyed. Flight Lieutenant Erling Zieler, Squadron Leader Sholto Duncan, AC1 William Sharman and AC2 Russell Woodcock killed
