He was born at Geraldine twenty years ago, and educated at the Geraldine District High School. At the time of enlistment he was in the employ of Mr W. E. Evans, mercer, of Waimate. He was secretary to the Waimate branch of the Catholic Federation and to the St Patrick's Men's Club, Waimate.

Private William George Russell (killed in France on September 26, 1916) was the youngest son of Mr Geo. Russell, Geraldine. He left New Zealand with the Fifth Reinforcements. After the evacuation he went to France with the New Zealand forces from Egypt. At the time of enlistment he was in the employ of W. E. Evans. mercer, Waimate.
