The death occurred yesterday at Timaru of Mr William manifold Matson, eldest son of Mr Conway Matson, of Christchurch, at the age of 43 years. The late Mr Matson was educated at Christ's College, and subsequently joined the staff of the New Zealand Insurance Company. Later he became a salesman for Messrs H. Matson and Co., representing that firm in the fat cattle department at the Addington stock sale. Some years ago he was appointed head salesman for Messrs Guinness and Le Cren, stock auctioneers, Timaru (now Pyne, Gould, Guinness), and he remained in that position until the time of his death.
