OBITUARY

MR R. S. BREMNER

Mr Roland Scott Bremner, who died in Dunedin yesterday, was the second son of Mrs I. S. Bremner and the late Mr Philip Bremner, of Belleknowes, Dunedin. He was educated at the public school at Hyde, at the Timaru Boys' High School, and at Otago University. His studies were interrupted by the Great War, and he enlisted in the New Zealand Forces, serving with the infantry. In 1916, at the Somme, he was seriously wounded, suffering injuries which remained with him through life and ultimately brought about his death. He was a barrister and solicitor of the Supreme Court of New Zealand, and among other qualifications he was a Bachelor of Laws of the London University, England. When compelled through health to relinquish work he was engaged in the office of Mr R. R. Grigor, solicitor, of Balclutha, and his wide reading and success in court work had already earned for him a considerable reputation, which was well deserved. Mr Bremner was the Government nominee on the Board of Governors of the Balclutha District High School.
