

Mr and Mrs Ellis Mills, Church Street received advice from Wellington yesterday that their son, 38973, Stanley Charles, was dangerously ill on December 2nd, in the 14th General Hospital at Wimmereaux, from gunshot wounds in thigh and leg. Stanley Mills left with the 22nds, last February. When at Sling Camp, he was visited in April by his brother, Len, who left twelve months earlier, was wounded on the Somme and was recovering at Codford Convalescent Depot. The brothers left for France three days apart, in the last week in May. Both were employed in the Post Office, Timaru, before leaving, though the elder had been transferred to Eketahuna and enlisted there. He is now doing postal duty at the front. Stanley was in the Timaru Post Parcels Office.
