Mr A. E. Lowe, of Tai Tapu, has been advised by the Canadian Records Office that his son, Private Ernest George Strong Lowe was killed in action on May 13th in France. Private Lowe was born in Waimate, and brought up in Timaru. He went to Canada about ten years ago, and, when the war broke out, enlisted in the Winnipeg Grenadiers, 5th Canadian Battalion. He was 32 years of age. His brother, Private George Lowe, is in the Taranaki Company, of the Wellington Infantry Regiment. He was wounded at Gallipoli, but made a good recovery, and according to latest advices, was on leave in London. A sister, Miss M. C. Lowe, is nursing at the front. They are grandchildren of Mrs Strong, High Street, Waimate. Two other grandsons, Gordon G. Lyall and Angus Lyall, of St. Andrews, are at present in Trentham.
